**** Deed of Establishment of
The Congregation of the Redemptorists of Julian of Norwich as a Religious Order ****

We, Mar Trimlett, by the grace of God a catholic bishop announce by this deed the founding of a religious congregation to announce the good news of the Gospel and the unfailing love of Our Lord and Redeemer to the poor and abandoned through the worthy teachings of Mother Julian of Norwich and Saint Alphonsus Liguori, C.Ss.R. and serving particularly as expressed in the Old Catholic Apostolic Church in particular and the Old Catholic denomination in general.

The order shall be called ‘The Congregation of the Redemptorists of Julian of Norwich’ and may be referred to as the ‘Julian Redemptorists’ and recognised by its post nominal letters ‘JSsR’.

The Congregation of the Redemptorists of Julian of Norwich is a religious congregation, promulgated by us, Bishop Adrian, Mar Trimlett, Patriarch of the OCAC on the 22nd of August 2023. This congregation continues the missionary charism of the Redemptorists of Saint Alphonsus Liguori with special devotion and solicitude for the promulgation of the teachings of Mother Julian of Norwich and commits itself through religious consecration to preaching the Redeeming love of our Lord Jesus Christ and praying for the intercession and protection of the Blessed Virgin Mary, our Mother of Perpetual Help, in the spirit of Christ who said, “The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because He has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor” (Luke 4:18).

The Congregation of the Redemptorists of Julian of Norwich is open to all baptized men and women, both clergy and laity, of the Old Catholic Apostolic Church and other associated churches via the Independent Liberal Catholic Fellowship. Per the congregation’s constitutions and statutes, the evangelical counsels have been mitigated for secular life and there is no requirement for celibacy or for the sharing of goods in common. Per Redemptorist custom, the recitation of the Rosary, the adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, and the practice of the daily examen of Saint Alphonsus Liguori is to be encouraged by its members.

The congregation is and always shall be a part of the Old Catholic Apostolic Church worldwide—as incorporated in England and Wales whose present number is 07221223 and any subsequent incorporation of that body as may occur from time to time—and shall be subject to the canons of said church, and the authority of its Patriarch, and church leadership.

The congregation shall be free to choose its own structure, be responsible for its own leadership and the accuracy of its teaching, although the patriarch of the OCAC is the final arbiter in all decision and the patriarch’s mandates and guidance overrule other decisions. The constitutions and statutes of the congregation may be amended by the patriarch of the OCAC at any time, who will take into account the wishes of the members of the congregation balanced with the overall good of the Church and her members.
